Our first few events were small but demonstrated that the spirit of racing was still alive and looking for a comeback.

Over the following few years we continued to develop a strong relationship with the local teams, drivers, media and spectators.

All our continuous efforts led to a payoff when the crowd of spectators started to grow by leaps and bounds.

At which point we decided that a large event needed to be held, the first **Miami 500** was held in December of 2012.

The event was the first of its kind since the Miami Grand Prix in the 80's. Drivers from around the world joined in as did the media and spectators.

Following that success we held other large events like the **Homestead 500** and the **Sunset 500** which have also experienced great success.

- 2017 marks the start of the FRRC (Florida Road Racing Championship) Homestead-Miami Speedway , Sebring International Raceway and Daytona Speedway.

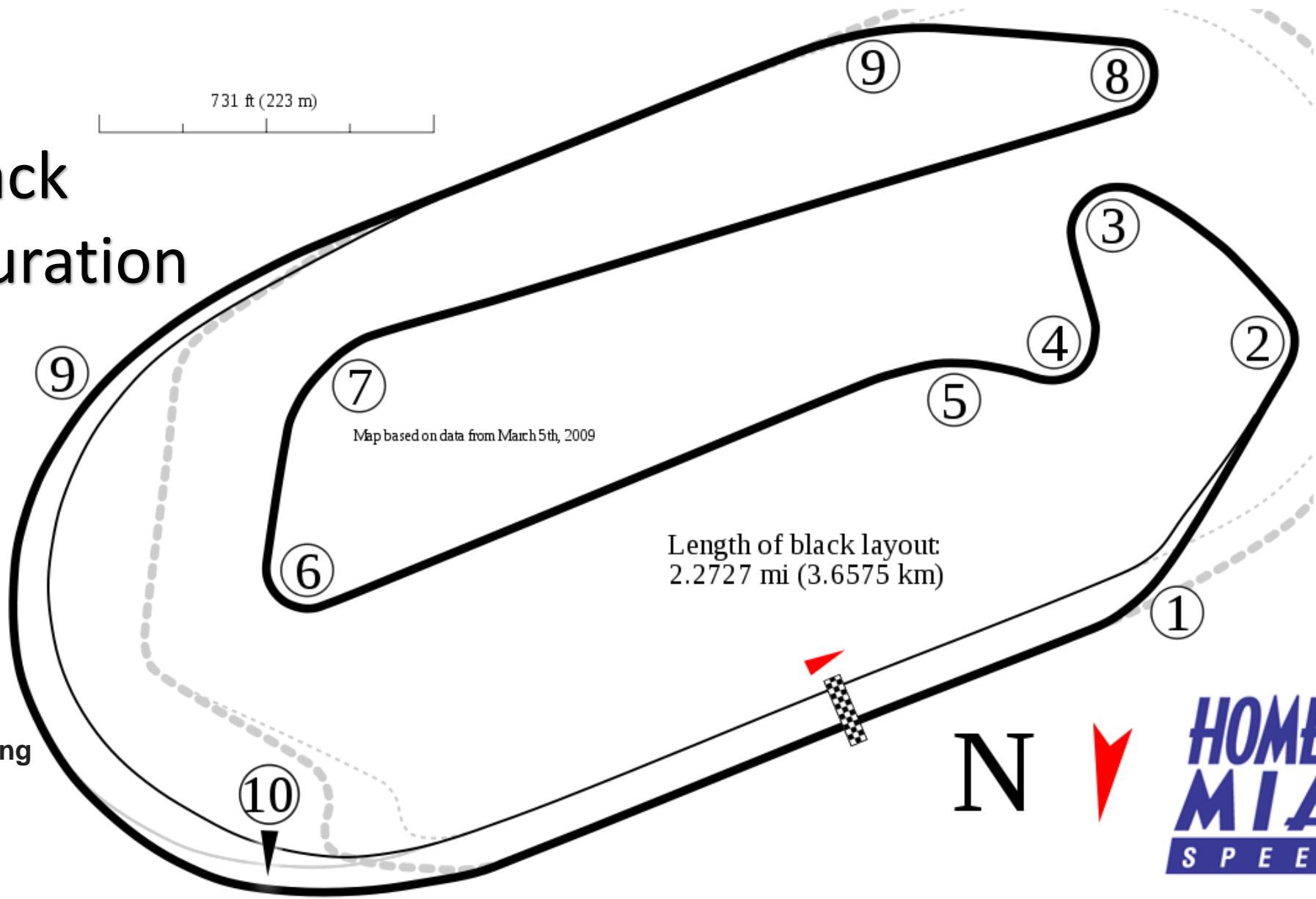

- 12 HOUR entry fee \$2,500.00 Additional drivers \$500.00 each.
- Early registration discount of \$250.00 **(To take advantage of the discount all you need is to register with the \$500.00 early registration deposit option before October 15th, 2017)**
- Included in registration fee: One driver, 30 minutes open practice, 30 minutes qualifying, 2 hour night practice on Friday and one car garage space. **(Extra garage space and full garages are available at an additional cost)**
- Optional test time from 12 noon to 1:30 pm on Friday is \$200.00. No additional charge for drivers.
- Three hours is the maximum time that a driver is allowed to drive continuously.
- FARA welcomes all international and US competition licenses FIA ,IMSA, SCCA, NASA, PBOC etc. (No additional cost for FARA competition license)
- Race start 11:00 am to 11:00 pm Saturday, December 9th, 2017.

- **Hankook is the spec tire of the 12 hours, Teams have the option of running other brands of tires with a 6 lap penalty.**
- Maximum of 50 cars to compete in the MIAMI 12 HOURS.

- To receive the full overall prize money or bonus the winners must pass underneath the checkered flag and a minimum of 4 cars must start the race in your class, otherwise half the prize money or bonus will be given.
- To win the full prize money or bonus amount you must complete 70% of the winner laps in your class. A minimum of 50% of the winner laps in your class must be completed to be eligible for half of the prize money or bonus.
- The Class bonus is only good for the MIAMI 500, February, 2018.

- The **(Grid walk)** allows fans to walk on the front straight and interact and engage series teams and drivers.

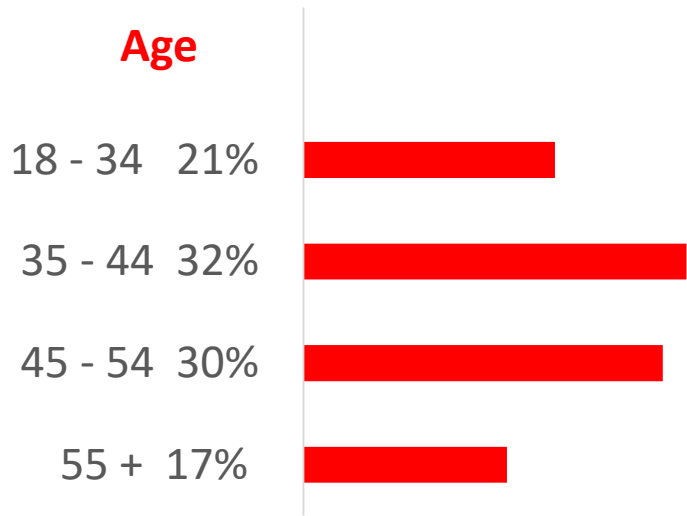

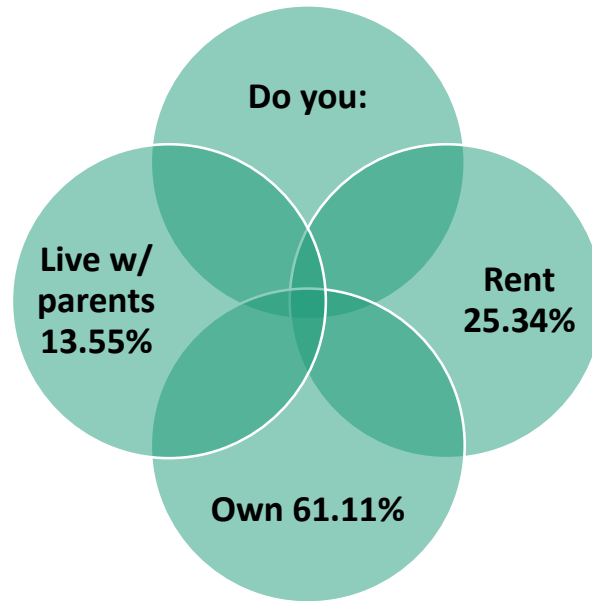

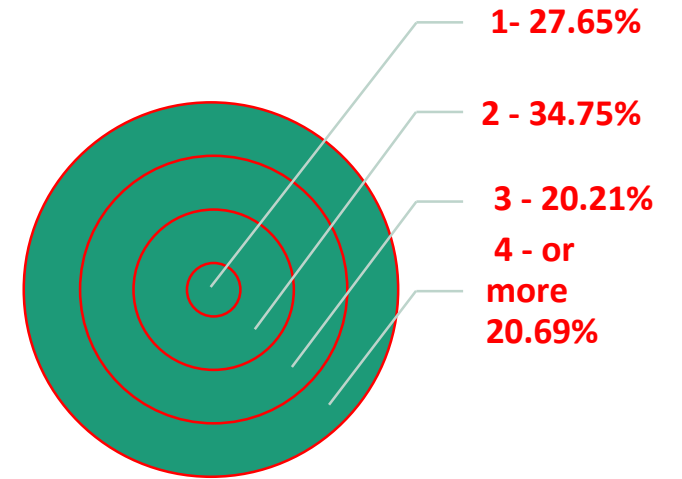

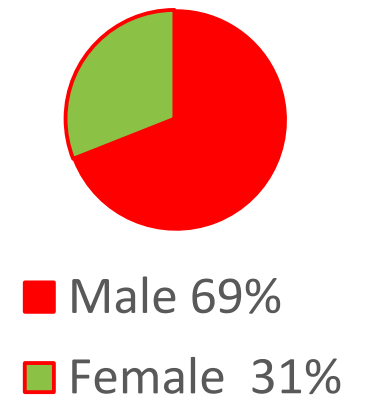
Household Income
